OUR COMMITMENT

At Vapor Ministries, we believe that how we serve matters as much as what we provide. Excellence is not optional when it comes to meeting basic needs. It is an expression of honor, dignity, and devoted service to the people God has entrusted to our care.

At our Kawangware center, the well provides essential water for daily ministry and community use. Recent water testing shows that although the water is free of dirt and visible sediment, it has developed a yellow tint due to high levels of naturally occurring dissolved iron in the groundwater.

While iron is common in wells, it discolors water when exposed to air. Over time, this affects usability, taste, staining, and long-term infrastructure. More importantly, it falls short of the standard of excellence we strive to uphold in every aspect of service.

WHY THIS UPGRADE MATTERS

Providing water that is merely “usable” is not enough. Our calling is to provide water that is clean, clear, and worthy of the families who rely on it. Investing in proper iron removal reflects our dedication to:

- Excellent stewardship of resources
- Long-term sustainability of the well system
- Care that honors people physically and relationally
- Ministry environments that reflect dignity and trust

We are proposing a three-stage filtration system designed specifically to remove dissolved iron and deliver consistently clear, safe water. The result will be:

- Clear, iron-free water
- A higher standard of care for families and staff
- Reduced staining and wear on infrastructure
- A reliable, long-term solution aligned with local groundwater conditions
