STRATEGIC LOCATION



Vapor Ministries' headquarters is located in Fayetteville, Alabama; a quiet, family-friendly town 45 minutes southeast of Birmingham. Positioned directly across from renowned Pursell Farms, this setting is ideal for hosting fundraising events and stakeholder retreats in addition to lodging potential partners. The Vapor story and materials are on display throughout The Inn and across the sprawling grounds.

The Pursell family are long-standing ministry supporters and in 2007 graciously donated the property on which the headquarters now sits.

While the cost of living in the area is low, quality homes and apartments are in short supply. This, coupled with the lack of social, recreational, and retail conveniences offered in other cities makes attracting high-capacity team members challenging.

ATTRACTING TALENT

To overcome these limitations, the Pursell family donated an additional 12 acres specifically for team housing development in 2009. Today, five homes provide safe, convenient, no-cost housing to mission-minded individuals as part of their compensation package. This project has been proven incredibly successful and gives the organization a competitive advantage when attracting and retaining top-tier talent.

Offsetting this premium financial obligation not only eliminates housing concerns, but bolsters relocation incentive and erases the cost and mechanical wear resulting from extensive commutes.
