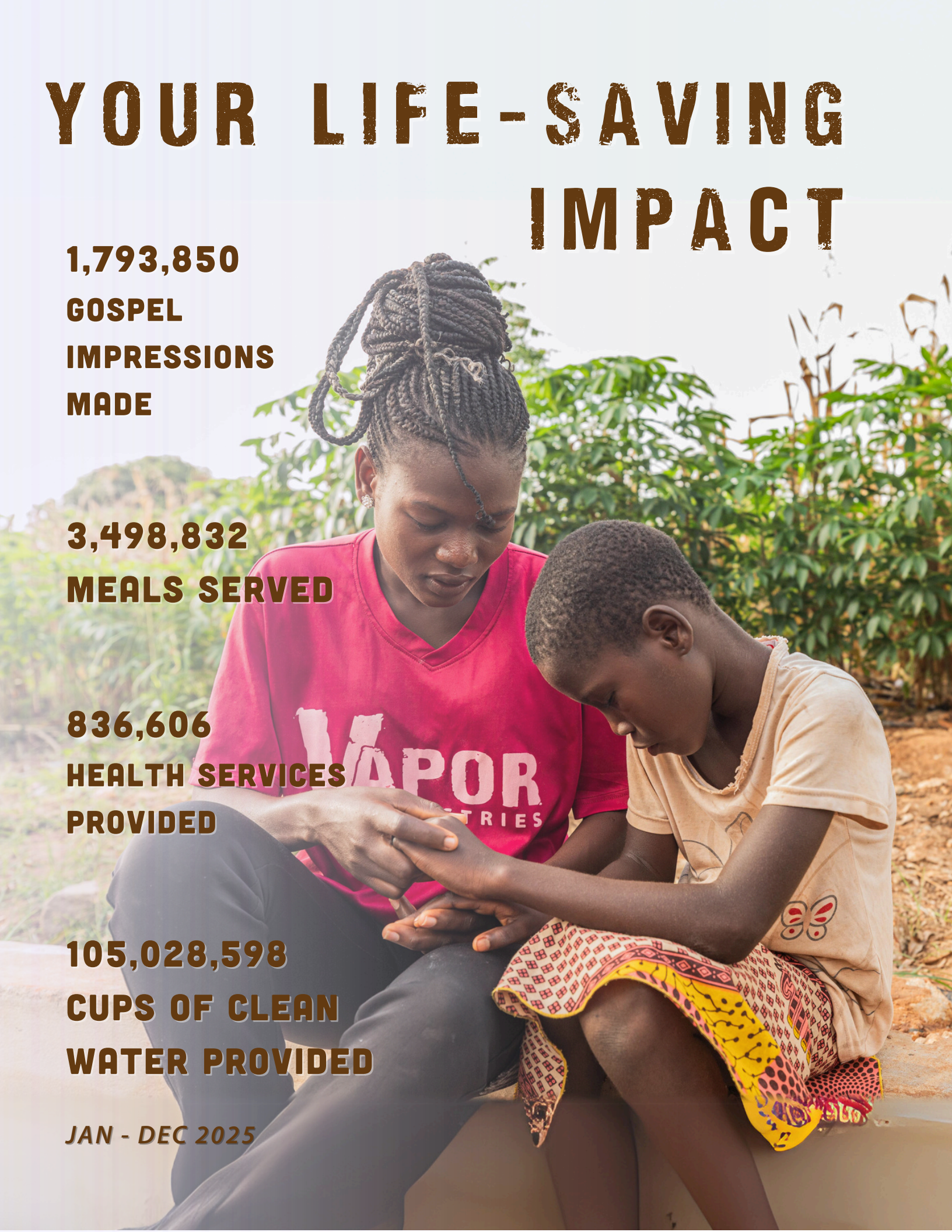

OUANAMINTHE CENTER ADMIN BUILDING REMODEL

The Ouanaminthe center serves as a community hub for Vapor Ministries' outreach initiatives, including discipleship, education, food and water security, and healthcare. However, the current Administration Building requires remodeling to meet the growing needs of our leadership team and improve the building's functionality. Key improvements include the creation of dedicated workspaces, a multi-purpose room for community engagement, and upgraded facilities for team well-being. This remodel will enhance our operational capacity by optimizing space, improving functionality, and creating a more welcoming environment. By upgrading this facility, we aim to provide our local leadership team with an effective base of operations to support our community programs, ensuring that we can meet the needs of the people we serve with greater efficiency and impact. This remodel will also facilitate improved communication between our local team, the Haiti Regional Office, and our U.S. headquarters, strengthening global alignment and accountability.

Lobby Area

Revamping the lobby to create a more welcoming space for the team, discipleship league participants, and community members seeking aid. The improved layout will better reflect the mission and professionalism of Vapor Ministries and offer a warm, organized entry point to the building.

Team Members' Offices

Creating efficient shared workspaces designed to promote collaboration and support focused work. Each area will allow multiple team members to operate effectively, strengthening productivity and teamwork.

Center Manager's Office

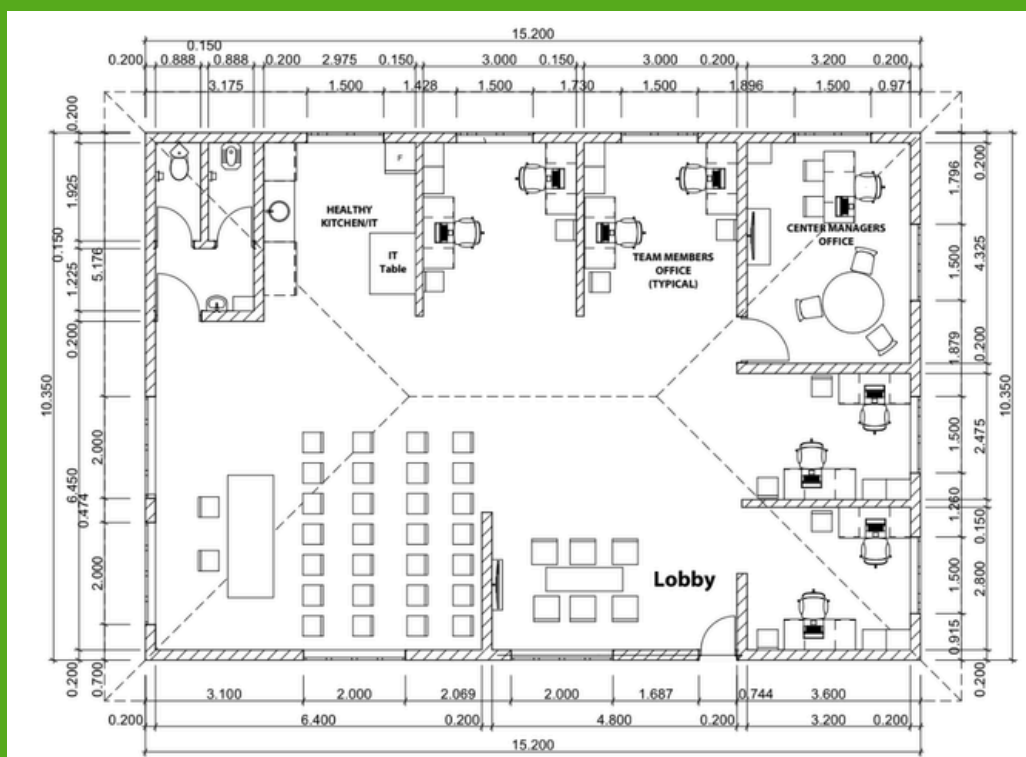
Upgrading the manager's office to provide a private, functional space for overseeing center operations, meeting with direct reports, and handling sensitive information with care.

Multipurpose Room

Transforming an existing area into a flexible room for meetings, training sessions, and community gatherings. This enhanced space will support outreach and discipleship efforts by offering an adaptable environment for meaningful group activities.

Healthy Kitchen and IT Room

Remodeling this space to integrate a small kitchen that supports team well-being alongside a dedicated IT workspace. The combined design will provide the team with a place to recharge while maintaining the technical resources needed for smooth, reliable operations.
