Pavers Around Admin Building

The area surrounding the Administration Building at the Togoville Center is prone to erosion and water pooling during the rainy season. Laying pavers will improve drainage, reduce mud and dust, protect the building's foundation, and create safer walkways for team members and visitors. This upgrade enhances both durability and accessibility for daily operations.

West Africa Regional Office Additional A/C Unit

At the West Africa Regional Office, increased program usage and team member presence have created the need for an additional air conditioning unit. Installing this unit will improve working conditions, protect equipment, and allow ministry and administrative activities to continue effectively in extreme heat.
